The secondary purpose is to foster the spiritual and social welfare of the women of the Parish through faith-sharing talks, prayer especially the Rosary, classes on embroidery and sewing, and volunteer work in the local community. Membership is open to ladies of all ages of the parish. Meetings are held in the narthex of All Saints on some Fridays each month.

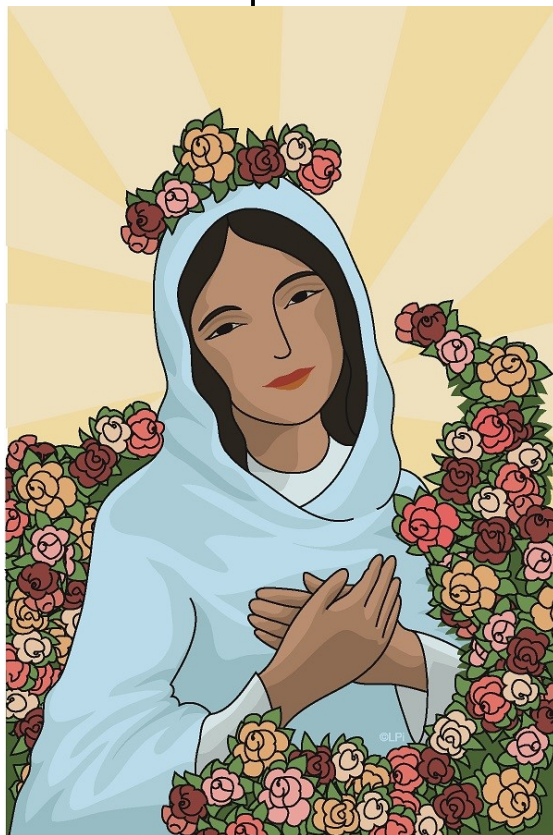

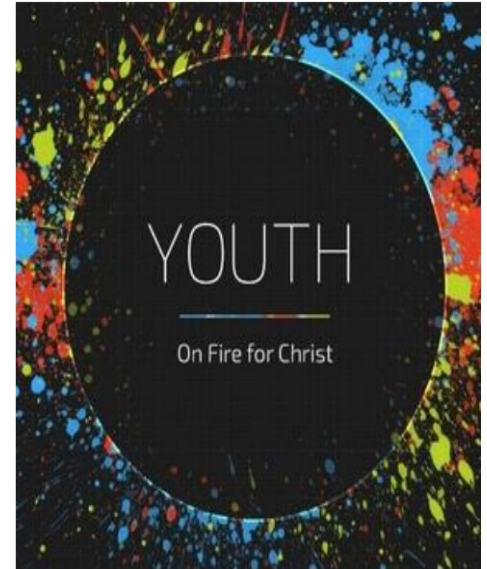
